

# SOLID WASTE COMPLEX / RECYCLE CENTER

**DIRECTIONS:** Traveling south on Highway 11-71, about a mile past Menards, take a left turn off the highway just past KBHW Radio Station. (across from County Road 105). There are green highway signs marking its location.

**HOURS OPEN:** Monday – Saturday – 8:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m. (closed holidays)

**ACCEPTABLE ITEMS (coupon required):** Garbage, furniture, mattresses, box springs, demolition, appliances, TV's, computer monitors, and tires are accepted but tickets must be purchased before bringing these items to the facility. (see prices listed below)

**ACCEPTABLE ITEMS (free of charge):** Used oil, oil filters, vehicle batteries, cardboard, magazines, aluminum and metal cans, all #1 & 2 plastic colored or clear, mixed paper, scrap metal and yard waste.

**COUPONS SOLD AT:** Super Value, Outdoorsman Headquarters, Falls Lumber Co., Rainy Lake One Stop and at the Courthouse in the Environmental Services Department .

**PRICES:** Garbage \$11.00 per cubic yard  
3 garbage coupons available: 1 cubic yard / 8 bags \$ 11.00  
2 cubic yard / 4 - ½ yd punches \$ 22.00  
single bag (33 gallon) \$ 1.50

Demolition \$ 11.00 per cubic yard

Garbage coupon is used for either garbage or demolition. Please separate demo from garbage. Demolition goes in the demo site behind building and garbage goes inside the building. **Please see attendant before dumping.**

Tire coupons: passenger and light truck tire up to and including 16 inch: without rim \$ 2.00 each  
with rim (2 tickets) \$ 4.00  
large truck tire: without rim \$ 7.00 each  
with rim (2 tickets) \$ 14.00

Appliances include microwave, air conditioner washer, dryer, stove, fridge, hot water heater, freezer: \$ 5.00 each

TV's and computer monitors: \$ 5.00 each

Hazardous Waste Collections are held in June and August of each year at the Solid Waste Complex located in International Falls. They are free to households. Businesses must pre-register and pay a fee. Call the Environmental Services Department for exact dates and time.
