NOTICE TO CONTRACTORS - Sealed proposals will be received by the Koochiching County Board of Commissioners until 2:00 P.M. on February 22, 2012 at the office of the County Auditor in the Courthouse in International Falls, Minnesota at which time they will be opened and read publicly for the following:

2012 Culvert Replacements

- 1) **SAP 036-608-016 (CSAH 8)** from TH 217 to TH 65 near Littlefork. Culvert replacements. 18.9 mile length. The major quantities include 2,460 Lin. Ft. of RCP culverts and 1,334 tons bituminous wear.
- 2) **SAP 036-615-010 (CSAH 15)** 2 miles NW of Northome. Culvert installation. The major quantities include 76 Lin. Ft. of RCP culvert.
- 3) **SAP 036-630-016 (CSAH 30)** 5 miles West of Big Falls. Culvert replacements. The major quantities include 318 Lin. Ft. of RCP culverts.
- 4) **SAP 036-631-016 (CSAH 31)** 6 miles East of Big Falls. Culvert replacements. The major quantities include 106 Lin. Ft. RCP culverts.

The County Board reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive irregularities and informalities therein and to award the contract to the best interests of the County.
