County residents can visit www.caremark.com/naco to print a live ID card and access other program tools. Savings are available immediately at any participating pharmacy.

Obtaining the card is easy, and to print a card residents:

1. Access www.caremark.com/naco and select “Print a card”
2. Utilize the map tool to enter the zip code or select the relevant state and county
3. Select next and the ID card is generated for printing
4. Use the card immediately at any participating pharmacy
